- [Still a few assemblies to go into and aware students what is happening. \(Harriet and Will\)](#)

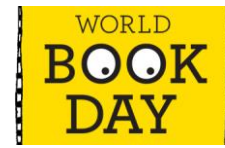
Buddy Scheme
