CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PUPILS

All pupils have the right to expect a high quality education. No pupil has the right to disrupt lessons so that teaching and learning are interrupted for other members of the class.

ALL PUPILS ARE EXPECTED TO:

- Follow instructions given in class LEARN TO LISTEN LISTEN TO LEARN
- Bring the correct books and equipment to school each day.
- Show courtesy and respect to staff, visitors and each other.
- Be polite...... always say please and thank you.

- Be punctual to lessons.
- Keep the school free from litter.

REMEMBER

Keep your equipment organised in your school bag and use a school locker to keep items safely locked away.

PLUS
