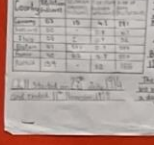


BRITISH ENGINE SERVICE MEN IN THE WAR

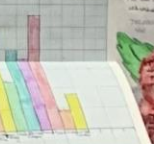


World War 1

Over 65 million men served in WWI. They spent 60% of their lives in the war. About 20 million men died and 11 million were injured.

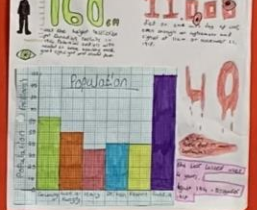

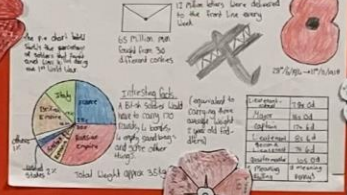

Did you know that 10 million died in WWI which is equivalent to the entire population of Belgium. The phrase that started WWI was 'France has been declared an enemy state'.



On 1 July 1916, the British forces suffered 17,000 casualties, including 10,000 dead. The youngest person who fought in WWI was 12.

4 out of 10 people survived the trenches. 900,000 tons of explosives.

It was the first war fought in the air

After the Wright Brothers made their first flight, more than 1000 bombing raids were produced by both sides

Germany built 153 Zeppelins, which carried out more than 100 bombing raids on Great Britain

Not all aircraft were built to carry bombs, some were used to carry messages along the front

America's top ace, Eddie Rickenbacker, had 16 kills

Germany's Manfred von Richthofen, best known as the "Red Baron", had 80 kills
