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National Education Union (NEU) Industrial Action

The NEU Has scheduled a further 2 days of industrial action this term. We will inform you as soon as possible if these details change. Further information from the NEU can be found <u>here</u>.

The planned dates for Industrial Action in Wales are:

- Wednesday 15 March 2023
- Thursday 16 March 2023

Throughout the week, we have again been working closely with our staff to ensure that we all understand the situation around this planned action and importantly, recognise the right of all staff to make a personal choice.

After full consideration of the numbers of staff who are members of the NEU, the Senior Team has completed a risk assessment. We have looked at the school timetable for the 2 days and in doing so, we have tried to balance the issues of the safe supervision of large numbers of pupils given reduced staffing levels, and the need to secure the continuing education of pupils, particularly those engaged in examination courses. The impact of the industrial action on the school is likely to change over time with every school day being different in terms of the effect on each individual year group. Therefore, on Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 March 2023, if the action goes ahead, the arrangements below will apply.

Open for:

All Sixth Form pupils All pupils entitled to free school meals.

Closed to:

Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 (except those entitled to free school meals).

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Although the school will be open on the 2 strike days for pupils entitled to free school meals, we understand that this might cause difficulties for families. Therefore, if pupils prefer, they can obtain a packed lunch from the canteen on Tuesday 14 March to consume at home, rather than attend school on 15 and 16 March. If pupils wish to **order and reserve** a packed lunch they will need to do this in the school canteen at the end of their usual lunch session on Monday 13 March. Pupils can collect their packed lunches at the end of their usual lunch session on Tuesday 14 March. Pupils will also need to inform the members of staff taking the orders whether they wish to have a vegetarian option and/ or have any specific food allergies.

The Year 8 GCSE Information Evening scheduled for Wednesday 15 March will go ahead as planned unless you are informed differently.

As outlined previously, the school is bound by a number of regulations surrounding strike action and this includes being prohibited from recruiting agency staff to replace colleagues who take part in strike action. (Section 2 Trade Union (Wales) Act 2017) Neither are we permitted to redistribute the duties of striking colleagues to non-striking colleagues. This includes the cover of, and/or preparation of work for, pupils - either in person or remotely - outside of their normal working terms.

We regret that this issue remains unresolved at national level and of the need to change our normal arrangements. It appears unlikely that the proposed industrial action will be averted but, if this were to happen, we will write to you to confirm that the school will be open as usual.

We must all hope that the issues over which the industrial action has arisen are resolved as soon as possible in the best interests of all our pupils.

As ever, thank you for your continued support and thank you in advance for your patience.

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
Clwb Cymraeg (Welsh Club)
