#### **Industrial Action**

As previously communicated, the National Education Union (NEU) postponed the industrial action scheduled for 14 February 2023. However the NEU is now planning a further three days of industrial action this term. We will inform you as soon as possible if these details change. Further information from the NEU can be found here.

The planned dates for Industrial action in Wales are:

- Thursday 2 March 2023;
- Wednesday and Thursday, 15 and 16 March 2023.

Throughout the week, we have been working closely with our staff to ensure that we all understand the situation around this planned action and importantly, show solidarity with all staff over their right to make a personal choice. Our staff do not wish to cause disruption to the education of our pupils; however, their pay and working conditions have been eroded over the past number of years. This has led to significant issues in the recruitment and retention of teachers in many subject areas. Over the past two years, Cowbridge School has struggled to attract and appoint high calibre teachers across an increasing number of subject areas as a result of recruitment issues associated with conditions of service for teachers.

After full consideration of the numbers of staff who are members of the NEU, the Senior Team has completed a risk assessment. We have looked at the school timetable for that day and in doing so, we have tried to balance the issues of the safe supervision of large numbers of pupils given reduced staffing levels, and the need to secure the continuing education of pupils, particularly those engaged in examination courses. However, as the planned strike day is a Thursday as opposed to the Wednesday which was affected during the last strike, individual year groups will be impacted differently. Therefore, on Thursday 2 March 2023, if the action goes ahead, the following arrangements will be in place:

#### Open for:

- All Year 11 pupils they will be sitting mock exams all day;
- All Sixth Form pupils;
- All pupils entitled to free school meals.

As a result of the arrangements above, the Year 11 mock exam scheduled for the morning of Tuesday 28 February (Welsh) will be moved to the afternoon of Thursday 2 March.

#### Industrial Action cont.

#### Closed to:

• All Year, 7, 8, 9, 10 (except those entitled to free school meals).

Although the school will be open on Thursday 2 March for pupils entitled to free school meals, we understand that this might cause difficulties for families. Therefore, if pupils prefer, they can obtain a packed lunch from the canteen on Wednesday 1 March to consume at home, rather than attend school on Thursday 2 March. If pupils wish to order and reserve a packed lunch they will need to do this in the school canteen at the end of their usual lunch session on Tuesday 28 February. Pupils will also need to inform the members of staff taking the orders whether they wish to have a vegetarian option and/ or have any specific food allergies.

The Year 7 Parents' Evening is scheduled for Thursday 2 March and as such will be affected by the industrial action. Year 7 parents/carers will receive a separate Parentmail communication regarding arrangements.

As outlined previously, the school is bound by a number of regulations surrounding strike action and this includes being prohibited from recruiting agency staff to replace colleagues who take part in strike action. (Section 2 Trade Union (Wales) Act 2017) Neither are we permitted to redistribute the duties of striking colleagues to non-striking colleagues. This includes the cover of, and/or preparation of work for, pupils - either in person or remotely - outside of their normal working terms.

We regret that this issue remains unresolved at national level and of the need to change our normal arrangements. It appears unlikely that the proposed industrial action will be averted but, if this were to happen, we will write to you to confirm that the school will be open as usual.

We must all hope that the issues over which the industrial action has arisen are resolved as soon as possible in the best interests of all our pupils.

As ever, thank you for your continued support and thank you in advance for your patience.


