We are now approaching the end of a very long and extremely busy half term. All of our pupils are no doubt ready for a break to rest, recharge and enjoy some time with friends and family.


We wish all families a very enjoyable half term holiday. We will welcome back all pupils on Monday 7 November 2022.

## INTRODUCTION TO ARCHERY

Would you be interested in a free 3-week introduction to archery course?

Archery is a sport demanding a range of skills from a steady hand, strong shoulders, flexible muscles, a keen eye and a cool disposition.

All coaching and equipment provided.

#### **WEEK ONE: HITTING THE TARGET**

From the very first session your instructor will take the group through the basic technique to get archers shooting their first arrows. You will start to understand the different phases that make up a single shot and try out scoring.

## **WEEK TWO: TAKING AIM**

You will be introduced to freestyle shooting, given time to refine your skills for an individual phase of shooting and develop your scoring as part of a team. You'll practice how to aim and release the arrow, and continue to get the feel for achieving good form.

#### WEEK THREE: GETTING THE GOLD

You will become more comfortable maintaining good basic form, developing your draw technique and shooting lots of arrows. Have the chance to win your first award.

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#### **Cowbridge Pride**



Other events included the Cowbridge Pride Fashion Show with shops from the high street promoting their clothing on the catwalk at the Bear Hotel. A disco concluded the Pride event at the Horse and Groom. All events were well attended and over £600 was raised for LGBTQI+ resources for the community.






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Next year's Pride is already being planned and it is scheduled for the week of 19th June promising an even bigger event!
