# **Covid-19 LFD testing update**

We have received updated information from the Vale of Glamorgan Council regarding Covid-19 LFD testing. They advise us to maintain the offer of test kits in December for all pupils and to encourage their take up and use. Pupils can obtain additional test kits from their form teachers during registration periods.

They have also provided the information below for your information:

Whilst settings are closed, LFD tests are still available, free of charge to anyone over the age of 11 to test twice a week (every 3 or 4 days) without any COVID-19 symptoms. You are encouraged to take a test:

- if you are travelling to other parts of Wales or the UK;
- if you are going to be in a higher risk situation including spending time in crowded or enclosed spaces;
- before you visit people who are at a higher risk of severe illness from COVID-19.

In the new year, we encourage staff and learners over 11 years to test twice with LFD (3 or 4 days apart) in the week before returning to school or college and to then continue testing regularly twice weekly for two weeks after the start of term in January. Individuals should use their own stock of LFDs or if their setting is closed, order from the community channel if additional supplies are needed.
