COVID-19 UPDATE: Covid-19 infection control

Dear Parent/Carer

Wales is now at Alert level 0 which means that Welsh Government has relaxed a number of protections which are now no longer proportionate to the risks being faced.

This means that the School now needs to reference the Welsh Government Local Covid-19 infection control decision framework for schools. The framework sets out arrangements for the delivery of learning in schools reflecting local risks and circumstances.

Most of our mitigations, such as one way systems and encouraging pupils to use the hand sanitiser provided will remain in place.

However, as we informed you before the half term holiday, the requirements relating to the wearing of face coverings will change.

As from today (28 February 2022), face coverings are not routinely recommended, but may be worn by secondary aged learners anywhere on the school site and in particular when moving around indoor communal areas outside of the classroom, such as corridors.
