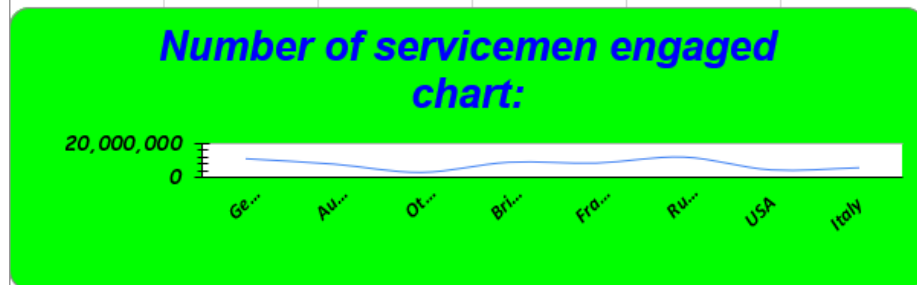
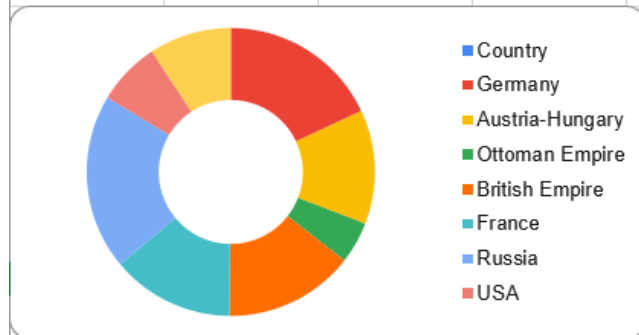


WW1 numeracy mission: Statistics of the numbers of men who died/wounded.
