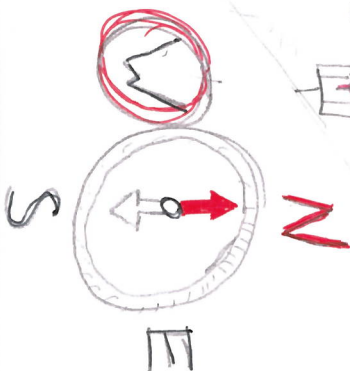

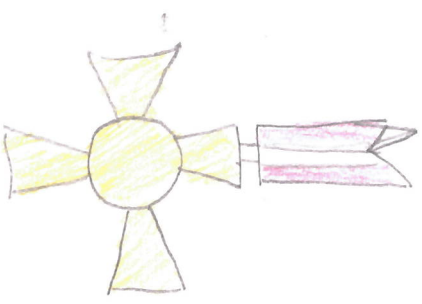
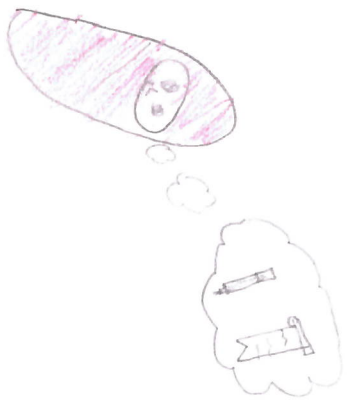


He enlisted in the army in 1915 and was commissioned into the Manchester Regiment. After training, he left for the Western Front



After heavy fighting, he was diagnosed with shellshock and was sent to Craiglockhart hospital near Edinburgh.

Wilfred Owen was an English poet and soldier. Owen was born on 1893 in Shropshire England.



He returned to France on August 19 18 and was awarded the Military Cross for bravery.



Sadly he was killed in action trying to lead his men across the Sambre Canal one week before the



The news of his death reached his parents on November 11, Armistice Day.
