Your half term challenge is to find out about WW1 in words and numbers by completing a literacy and numeracy mission.

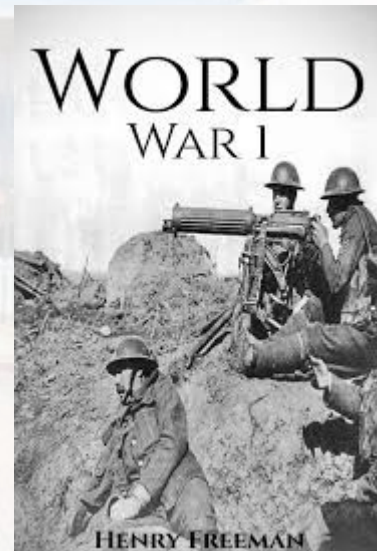
This mission will help you prepare for, and get the most out of, your history lessons after half term.
