

School Council meeting agenda 24.11.22 The meeting will be led by the Head Boy and Head Girl.

- 1. Email from Child.com-Thank you very much to you all for your help in supporting children and young people to share their views through our Ambitions for Wales survey. Thank you. Over 8 thousand children and young people took part, as did over a thousand parents and professionals who work with children. The next steps for us are to analyse all of the answers, and to write a work plan based on what children, parents, and adults who work with children have told us. We'll publish this next year. In the meantime, the level of worry amongst children and adults about the cost of living crisis is very clear in early results. We've decided to publish some early figures about this because of the huge importance and urgency of this issue, and share them directly with the government. The figures and the Commissioner's response are on our website.
- 2. I would like to discuss starting up more clubs unrelated to language, sport or music for year 7 and maybe year 8. Currently only one club exists to meet those criteria, so I would love to start up other clubs, such as chess, public speaking and programming clubs.
