The next steps for us are to analyse all of the answers, and to write a work plan based on what children, parents, and adults who work with children have told us. We'll publish this next year. In the meantime, the level of worry amongst children and adults about the cost of living crisis is very clear in early results. We've decided to publish some early figures about this because of the huge importance and urgency of this issue, and share them directly with the government.
