Government policy changes.

In order to distribute these tests to pupils who wish to participate in the testing from

home, they can collect their packs at the following times. Participation is voluntary and

in line with the Welsh Government advice and guidance. The School will not require any

written permission from pupils or parents as the tests are conducted at home and no

testing will take place on school premises. Pupils must only perform tests from home

and take action in accordance with the information.

Any pupil with symptoms of Covid-19 or a positive Lateral Flow test must stay away

from school and seek a full PCR test as soon as possible.

Pupils who have a negative PCR test can return, after confirming that the test result is

negative, via the relevant achievement office.
