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Youth Summer Volunteering Programme



TIME COMMITMENT 6 weeks -22 July to 30 August 2024. Twice a week Tuesdays and Thursdays, for 2 hours each session. LOCATION University Hospital Wales or University Hospital Llandough. You will be allocated a site. REQUIRED CHECKS* Enhanced DBS Occupational Health Check Individual Risk Assessment Two references 'All carried out by the Health Board

You will spend 6 weeks volunteering at the Health Board experiencing each of the following 2 roles with time allocated to each role as you move through the programme.

Welcome Team Volunteers (public areas)

You will be welcoming staff and visitors to the hospital and directing people to the location as required or you will be helping them through the appropriate pathway. You will also be helping to answer queries where possible.

Patient Engagement Volunteers (wards & public areas):

You will be based on our wards, outpatient departments and other areas across the Health Board. You will be spending time with patients, engaging them in conversation or activities and gathering feedback based on their hospital experience via Patient Surveys.

Youth Board Taster Meeting:

Additionally, you will also be given the opportunity to attend a Youth Board meeting (meetings are held monthly) with the Youth Board Lead and their current members: The Youth Board participates in decision-making processes in the Health Board. They are consulted on a variety of topics, but the majority of consultations are related to Children and Young People. In their monthly meetings they hold discussions, feedback sessions, training sessions and often have guest speakers.





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What we ask of you

- You must be able to volunteer twice a week Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the 6 week programme.
- You will either be placed at University Hospital Wales or University Hospital Llandough (times and locations of your volunteering will be allocated to you).
- As a volunteer, the right to work within the UK is still needed and as part of our recruitment process, the relevant documents will be checked. You need to give this consideration before applying.
- Willingness to undertake NHS training
- · You must be aged 16-25 to be eligible for this role

What's in it for you

- We will do our best to put you into pairs so that you are not volunteering alone.
- The programme can help you to develop your confidence, communication, teamworking, problem-solving skills and more.
- All volunteers are supported throughout the programme by the Voluntary Services Department staff.
- At the end of the programme volunteers who completed the 6 weeks will receive certificates and a reference to evidence that you volunteered with us.
- There will be opportunities for you to continue volunteering with us after the programme end date and these will be outlined towards the end of the programme.

We might inform someone if we were concerned about your safety, but we would usually speak to you first. Your messages are stored and can be seen by other healthcare staff who follow the same confidentiality rules. We aim to reply to you within one working day and you should get an immediate message back to confirm we received your text. Texts will not be seen outside normal working hours. If you need help before you hear back from us, contact your GP, nearest walk in centre or dial 111. Our text number does not receive voice calls or MMS picture messages. We support messaging from UK mobile numbers only (which does not include messages sent from landlines, international mobile numbers and some 'number masking' mobile apps). To prevent the health professional from sending messages to you, text STOP to our number. Messages are charged at your usual rates.

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School Attendance

We need you to.....

• Send your child to school on time.

- Ring/Text school early and daily if your child can not attend.
- Avoid holidays in term time.
- Keep school informed of your updated contact number.

We will.....

- Keep you regularly informed of your child's attendance.
- Treat any information you give us in a supportive and sensitive way.
- Welcome your child every day.
- Be happy that you have chosen to give your child the opportunity of the best future.

We understand that sometimes getting your children up and out on time every morning can be difficult, particularly if your child doesn't want to go for some reason.

We know that children who miss even small amounts of education can fall behind quickly and can miss out on so much. Being in school and on time increases learning and social opportunities.

If you suspect that your child may be missing school or is unhappy at school, contact the school or the Inclusion Team who can help resolve any difficulties and offer friendly advice.

Make sure your child knows that you do not approve of them missing school for any reason, but be on the alert for any particular reasons for not attending school, like bullying, difficulties with school-work.

Here are some ways you can help.

Take an interest in your child's education, ask them what they did in school and celebrate their successes and listen to their worries.

If you can't help them, speak to the school and let them know of any difficulties.

Make sure you know the school's attendance policy; every school has one. If your child is absent get in touch with school. Staff will work with you to help improve the situation. It's better to contact us first so that we can make sure steps are taken to help you.

> Make sure your child arrives on time to start school.

If your child is away for other reasons like a doctor's appointment or the dentist, let the school know in advance. Please try and book appointments towards the end of the day.
